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Napoleon-native scientist to present on oceanography at DPL

DEFIANCE – As part of Defiance Public Library System's 'Oceans of Possibilities' Summer Reading Challenge, Napoleon native Dr. Chrissy Stover Wiederwohl will visit Defiance Public Library's Reading Room on July 28 at 5 p.m. to present on Antarctic oceanography.

Dr. Wiederwohl earned her B.S. in marine science from Coastal Carolina University in 2002, followed by her master's and Ph.D. in oceanography from Texas A&M University, where she currently serves as both an Instructional Associate Professor and Assistant Oceanography Department Head for Engagement and Graduate Affairs.

Dr. Wiederwohl has taken part in several research cruises in the Gulf of Mexico, and four different expeditions to the Southern Ocean, two of which began in Antarctica.

Her research is focused on currents and water mass structures of the Southern Ocean, decadal variability of water masses, and the Southern Ocean's role in climate change.
