## The Teen Winter Craze is ON! Teen Reading Challenge is Feb. 1-28

Defiance County readers in grades 6-12 are invited to join Defiance Public Library System's Teen Winter Craze reading challenge, taking place Feb. 1-28 on Beanstack.

Beanstack is an online platform (and an app) that aims to make logging your reading, writing book reviews, and connecting with your reader friends fun and easy. DPLS uses it year-round for reading challenges, which can all be found at defiancelibrary.beanstack.org.

The free Beanstack Tracker app is available for download in the App Store or Google Play. During the Teen Winter Craze, teens can register and log their reading on Beanstack (plus any book reviews written) to be entered into **weekly prize drawings**. Any reading counts, whether it be a book, e-book, or audiobook (and no, they do not have to be library books). **All who participate will earn an entry into the grandprize drawing for a Mystery Box!** Teens also can register for the challenge inside any DPLS library location, including Defiance Public, Sherwood Branch, and Johnson Memorial (Hicksville) libraries. ## The Digital Collection Just Got Better!

Beginning February 14, Defiance Public Library System is launching a new service within hoopla called **hoopla Flex**, in an effort to reduce the amount of time you spend waiting for your favorite titles.

### What is a hoopla Flex borrow?

In addition to the 8 hoopla Instant borrows you receive each month with your library card, you now have hoopla Flex borrows (up to 8 at once) that you can use on specially marked hoopla Flex materials.

With hoopla Flex titles, you will find thousands of new and popular books that you can borrow now or place on hold to read later. If you ever run out of hoopla Flex borrows, you can always return a checked out Flex item and select a new one. **Don't forget to check your holds on hoopla, as filled requests will expire in 48 hours.** 

What is the difference between a hoopla Flex Borrow and a hoopla Instant Borrow? Unlike the 8 hoopla Instant Borrows you receive each month, hoopla Flex Borrows don't have any monthly expirations. Each hoopla Flex title you borrow is available for 21 days.

### New to hoopla? Get Started Today!

If you aren't familiar with hoopla, you can read, watch, and listen to more than 950,000 eBooks, audiobooks, comics, movies, music, or television titles available to stream or download. You can sign up for hoopla with your library card at hoopladigital.com and download the hoopla app from your favorite app store.





# **OVERDRIVE APP USERS:** TIME TO SWITCH TO LIBBY!

Attention, OverDrive app users! OverDrive is discontinuing the legacy OverDrive app in April and transitioning users to the Libby app. Libby is OverDrive's newer app for browsing and enjoying digital content from Defiance Public Library System. Libby is made by the same people, with the same goal of connecting you to your library and to your favorite books, audiobooks, and magazines.

It's time to give Libby a try! All your loans, holds, and wish list items will be waiting for you in Libby when you add your library card. You can download the Libby app from the App Store or Google play, or visit libbyapp.com to get started.

Libby also comes with new features we know you'll love, like:

- Tags to categorize books however you'd like—you can even sync your OverDrive wish list into a tag!
- A central bookshelf for all loans and holds
- Customizable notifications for ready holds and more
- Compatibility with Apple CarPlay, Android Auto, and Sonos speakers
- Extra learning and entertainment resources
- Easy access to OverDrive support staff



Libby users: Look for the new **"Notify Me" tag**, which replaces Overdrive's "Recommend to Library" feature and allows you to tag titles we don't own, and get notice if they are added to the collection.








# Odds + Ends
