DPL's Black Swamp STEAM Day Camp set for July 24-27

[DEFIANCE] – Kids in grades 3-5 are invited to explore the history and science of the Black Swamp during Defiance Public Library's Black Swamp STEAM Day Camp, taking place July 24-27 from 9:30-11:30 a.m. in the Summer Reading Tent on the Fort Grounds.

Participants will do hands-on data collection and learn about the water, soil, plants, and animals that share this place we call home. The library will welcome different visitors each day, like the Andrew L. Tuttle Memorial Museum, Defiance City Water Treatment Plant, Ohio Department of Natural Resources, the Black Swamp Conservancy, and more.

The Black Swamp STEAM camp is supported by the Friends of Defiance Public Library and a grant from the Ohio Environmental Education Fund, obtained by Defiance Elementary School teacher and program co-coordinator Julie Houck. The day camp is free, but space is limited, and registration is required.
